

Dear fellow NA members and Groups of the Fellowship Service Conference,

First of all we hope you are all doing well! It is exciting to hear that the Groups have been active and successful in carrying our message all over the world. The Conference is always a great vehicle of bringing the Groups together and to communicate growth and inspiration with each other. In this report we would like to briefly state some of the developments that have been going on.

The proposals that were brought by the Groups as well as the existing old business from previous years, have been turned into finalized motions after the deadline of January 1st.
